Bring your printed or digital ticket via smartphone for entry. To expedite the check-in process, please have your ticket or badge out and ready to be

scanned – either pulled up on your phone (turn up the brightness!) or via good old-fashioned print out.

This event will take place rain or shine; please plan accordingly
No firearms or weapons permitted. Violators are subject to forfeiture or arrest.

No Photos or Videos are allowed on the 2nd floor.
The 2nd floor of the museum is a phone-free zone. You will be asked to place it in a [Yondr](#) pouch. Your phone will be safely locked in the pouch and you will hold onto it. Once you leave the phone-free zone your pouch will be unlocked.

Attire

This is a cocktail event. Wear something dressy that makes you feel great but is also comfortable, keeping in mind that this event's main event is outdoors and temperatures will fluctuate. We recommend dressing in layers, as it will be breezy on the water. Be sure to wear comfortable shoes! You will definitely get those steps for the day in!

Transportation & Parking

Guests are encouraged to park in the Aquarium Garage located at 24 Calhoun Street. Regular parking rates will apply. Once you exit the parking garage and take a left, you will walk south on Concord street towards the building. We will offer a complimentary shuttle service that will travel from the garage to the museum for those who do not want to walk and do not mind waiting.

The van will pick up in front of the garage and bring guests to the museum. From 7:15 p.m. - 9 p.m. The van will transport people from the museum to the parking garage beginning at 10:15pm.

Stay safe! We encourage our guests to utilize rideshare services, which you can download directly to your smartphone.

Health & Safety

Taste of Black Charleston is NOT requiring proof of COVID-19 vaccination or negative COVID-19 test to attend the event. This is subject to change based on CDC and government mandates.
